

## FELLOWSHIP COMMUNICATIONS ACTION COMMITTEE

The Northern California World Service Area has formed Action Committees and aligned them with the functions listed by the World Service Office in the structure approved by the 2002 World Service Conference. Committees meet annually at the Assembly. They report on their progress since the previous assembly and make decisions as to what their tasks are for the following year. District Representatives present progress reports at the regular meetings of the Northern California World Service Committee, which meets three times per year between assemblies. The responsibilities of the Action Committees are the same as listed in the current World Service Office Conference Summary

Members of Action Committees include assigned members of the Northern California World Service Committee, District Representatives of assigned districts and the Group Representatives of those districts. By virtue of their positions, the following are members of all the Action Committees: “Floating” leadership between groups: Delegate, Immediate Past Delegate and Chairperson.
