The NCWSA Pink Can Fund provides Conference Approved Literature (CAL) to registered Al-Anon and Alateen meetings, as the incarcerated individual most likely will have little or no money to purchase Al-Anon/Alateen literature. Members donations to the Pink Can Fund creates an alternative source to provide CAL books, pamphlets and audio/video content when the District or AIS Inter-group where the facility exists does not have either the budget or excess funds to do so themselves.
